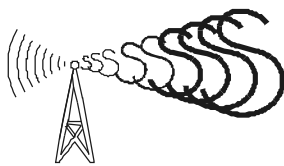


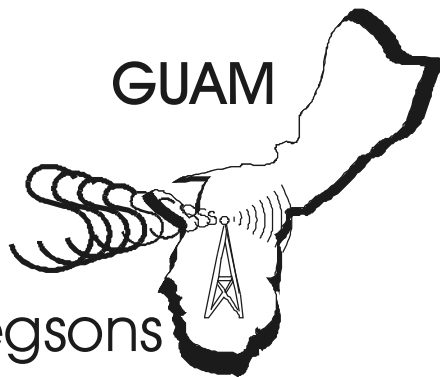

LOOKING AHEAD...

What is in store for 2006? It is appropriate at this time in world history that we look to the "Wonderful Counselor". As the frequency and scope of world disasters continue to rise we expect that many will be seeking answers and finding the Lord in the new year. In addition to traditional radio, there will be internet-delivered formats such as web audio streaming, podcasting, cell phone RSS feeds, etc.... Our goal is to have the system online in early 2006. Please pray for Doug, Matt, and the Singapore team as they work on this complex project.

Doug's brother, David, donated his time and experience to help with a survey of the TWR computer and technology systems in Asia in September. At the same time Doug traveled to Singapore to help co-workers install a new e-mail server and work on the IT infrastructure. We are always **looking for help** -- Do you know of anyone who would be interested in donating time, talent or resources to help reach Asia for Christ? If so, contact us.

Local ministries: In 2004 and 2005 you prayed for God to fill the house next door with a family that we could minister to and God answered those prayers!
