

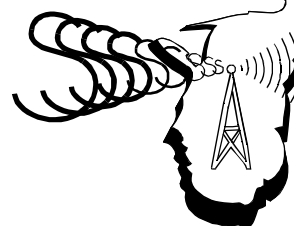

# ANSWER SHEET



1. C -- In our last letter we mentioned that KTWR is currently broadcasting 20 languages from Guam. Since that letter went out we have added three new languages!! They are Tibetan, Mongolian and a Russian dialect. Uyghur - spoken in northwestern China - is scheduled to begin in July.

2. C -- KTWR are the call letters of TWR- Guam's shortwave station on Guam (Station call letters East of the Mississippi begin with "W" and begin with "K" West of the Mississippi - Guam is *very* west!).

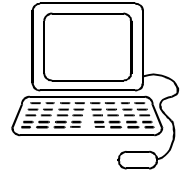


3. A -- We currently broadcast on five transmitters.

4. F -- From Guam we target all of Asia, Australia and the South Pacific.

5. D -- Over 50,000 Radio Church Packages have been distributed in China. A RCP includes a radio, Chinese Bibles, program schedules and Bible study materials.

6. B -- Asian producers create the programs locally and send them to Guam for broadcast.



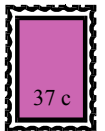
7. D -- All programming is now received through the internet.

8. C -- Doug is not directly involved in program production as that is mostly done in countries in Asia.

9. B -- As we mentioned in our last letter this is Doug's 14th year with TWR.

10. C -- Women of Hope is now aired over 400 times a week in 23 different languages.

11. A -- It is stunning to realize the power of shortwave radio to reach such large masses of people. Due to its strategic location, KTWR, Guam could potentially reach 50% of the entire world's population!



12. B-- Since Guam is a U.S. Territory an ordinary 37 cent stamp is sufficient --quite a bargain for such a long trip!

13. B --We are 14 to 15 hours ahead of East Coast Time (depending on daylight savings); that is where Guam got its slogan "*Where America's Day Begins!*"

14. C -- Sarah recently turned five years old and Joy recently turned three.
