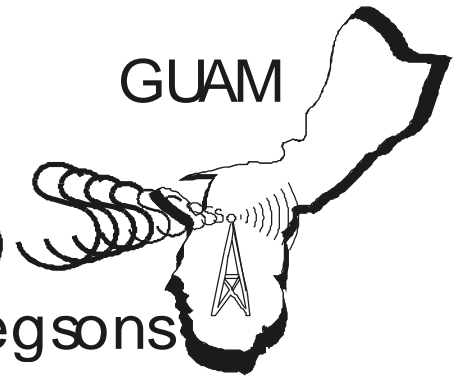

### Why a vision trip?

**Doug** – *Most of the time I work with computers and radio transmitter equipment on Guam, but I rarely get the chance to meet the people to whom we minister and would like to renew my vision.*

**Denise** – *I look forward to seeing and hearing firsthand what God is doing in Cambodia with women and children's ministries. And there is nothing like being miles away from the broadcast site we know so well and turning on the radio to hear our station.*

### **Cambodia Testimony:**

#### **A Khmer listener writes,**

*"I would like to thank Trans World Radio that is always concerned about my spiritual needs as well as Cambodian people. In this opportunity, I would like to tell you about how I became a believer. I became a Christian through my son in law. He is a very good servant to the Lord in serving His ministry. Since I became a Christian, I always meditate, learn, using the word of God to comfort my life. I am blind, I cannot see anything around. I always pray to God to help me to get closer to Him. I am very poor financially but I prayed to be poor spiritually. One day, I overheard God's words on radio from my neighbor's house. I was very hungry to hear His words but I did not have my own radio and cannot walk and find the way to get one. In my village, there are only two or three radios and those radios are so old that they sometimes work and sometimes not. Thankfully to the Lord our God for His kindness to me, I got one radio from Trans World Radio. I was very exciting. I believed that was the answer from God to me for what I had prayed to Him and He saw what I needed so He sent me that radio. Since I got a radio I found that my heart was relieved from stress and burden. Your programs are helping me improve my faith and always encourage me. Finally may God our Lord bless this ministry in order to help more Cambodian people to know God like me."*
