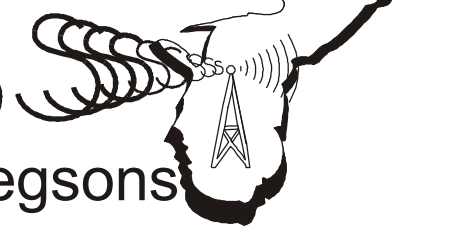

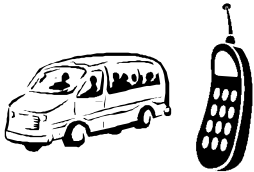

Arriving several hours late, they entered this dusty, barren place and found close to 300 women and children waiting patiently for them. Afterwards, each child was given a small food packet and donated clothes were passed out.."

discussed issues that are common to all the regions and strategized ways to support each other at a time where resources are being stretched to the maximum.

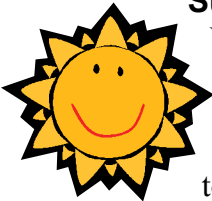
