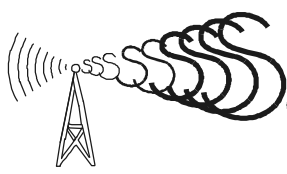


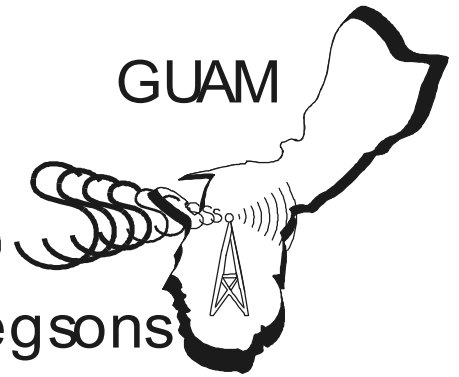

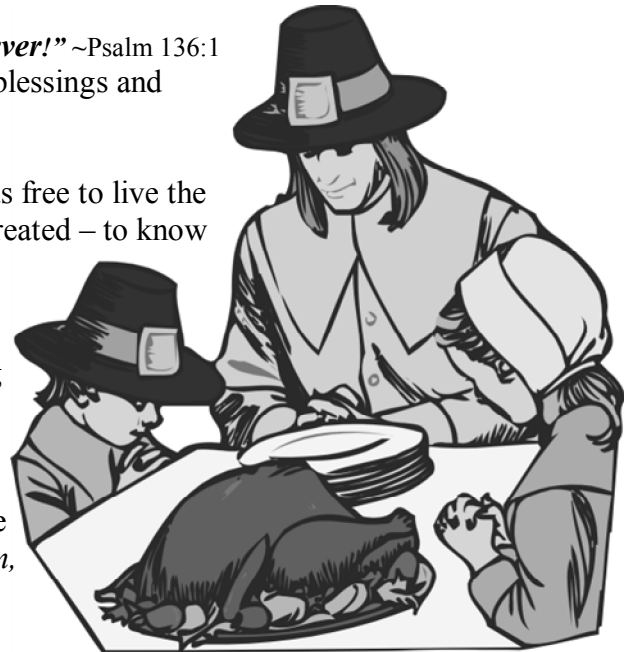

It is a privilege being part of a team that brings His Word to the multitudes in Asia. Here is a small sampling of some of the groups of people tuning in to the broadcasts:

A teen in Cambodia:

“I’m 15 years old. . . . I haven’t written a letter to you for a while because I wanted to wait until I knew the answers from the questions in your program, and then send it to you at one time. I really like to listen to the HCG [*Happy Children’s Garden*] program because this program helps me to change my life through Jesus’ Words. It helps me to respect my parents even when I get upset with them. Thank you so much for helping me to grow in faith in God, and through each question in your program, which helps me to gain wisdom, and to know more about the Bible.”

A Gentleman in Nepal:

"My name is "D" . . . I'm 61 years old man. I was born and brought up in [another religion] family. . . . My parents were devotees of [this religion], they used to worship statues, trees, stones, animals, sun, moon and different gods and goddesses. Till 55 years of age, I also led my life in that way worshipping creation of the earth. . . . After living [in this way] spending all money for eating, drinking, gambling . . . And then I became poor. . . . Later through [a friend] I came to know about Mukti Ko Sandesh [*The Word Today*] radio program. . . . The message from the program really touched me and I became a Christian. Now I don't have wealth but I have peace of mind. I thank the Lord for this wonderful opportunity to know the Lord Jesus through this radio program."

A Parent in Indonesia

"My name is "E" . . . I have problems in teaching my children. I thank God for your programs that guide me to love my children with the love of Jesus Christ. I learn how to forgive them, I learn how to build good relationships with them. Although my children often make me cry and sad I love them as Jesus Christ loves me. Again I thank God for your programs that lead me to build my personal faith in God. "

A New Sister in Christ in China:

"I am a new believer. In the past, because of the lack of a preacher in our church, I hardly knew anything about God, but after receiving RCP [Radio Church Package] and listening to your programs, I began to have some basic knowledge about God. In these end times, we have to follow Jesus, set Him as our goal and the cross as our center. We have to set a good foundation for our lives and to nurture our souls."

A Pastor in Cambodia:

"Hello! Sisters and brothers in the name of Jesus Christ, my name is Pastor "C" . . . I really love listening to the program "Thru the Bible" because it's very helpful to me. Since I have listened to the program "Thru the Bible" my preaching is much better, because I get a lot of ideas from it. Moreover, it helps me to love God in my heart and my soul. In short, I am thankful to Trans World Radio Cambodia which lent me an mp3 so that I can hear God's word every day. May God bless you all."

An Elderly Sister in China:

"Greetings! I received the letter and calendar that you sent to me in February 2009. I was extremely excited about this! You still care about this 91-year-old sister in Christ. My body is still fine, but my ears are not well and I can't listen to the broadcast very clearly. Thanks for your love and care about me. Please pray for me."
