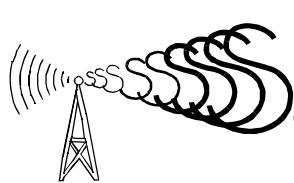


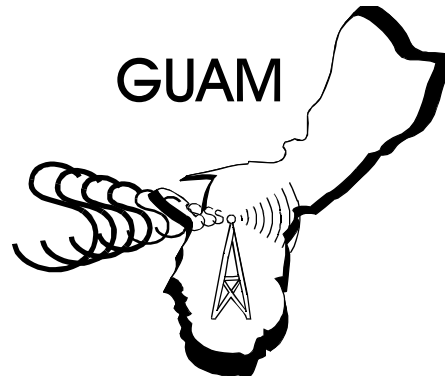

Sarah(5)wants to tell you...about living on Guam...

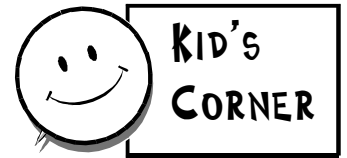
