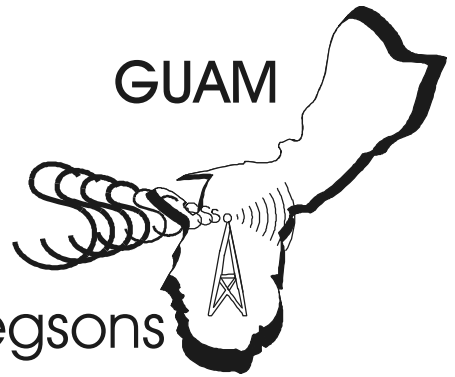

## On the Work Front:

In June, Doug took a trip to the Taiwan and Hong Kong offices to work on computer hardware and software upgrades. The trip was a great opportunity to build relationships with co-workers that he normally only works with remotely. Doug traveled with Mark Chang (a Systems Administrator from Singapore) to perform hardware maintenance, install a new server and update security systems.

Internet security is still one of the most important areas that demands constant care. It was appropriate that on the day Doug arrived in Hong Kong the front page headlines of the local newspaper read "Weak Security makes Hong Kong top hacker target". The survey referred to showed that most businesses are taking internet security seriously. However, many home users are not taking adequate precautions to protect home systems. As a result many home security problems spread to the office. Home and office internet security is critical to TWR Asia's efficient delivery of the Gospel. Almost all radio broadcasts rely on the Internet as does the Asia management and operational infrastructure data.



Back on Guam, Doug is enjoying sharing the workload with a new employee. In July, Matthew Birnie arrived on Guam to share the system administration work. Matt is a short-term missionary with TWR who will be working on Guam for about nine months and then he will return to the States to finish raising his support for full-time status. **Project Hannah Program Reaches Language Milestone** As of this summer Project Hannah's (PH) Women of Hope (WoH) program now reaches out in 30 languages worldwide! Newest languages added include the Lengua language to Paraguay and the languages of Cebuano and Ilocano to the Philippines. Production is underway for WoH broadcasts in Uzbek for Central Asia. Additionally, PH hopes to begin to air the English WoH program on a well-established Caribbean network.

#### New home power source



Doug installed a windmill to produce power that works with our solar system to offset the ever-increasing cost of electricity at home (about \$.15 per kW/hr). The windmill will also come in handy during power outages that occur due to storms and earthquakes. Currently the solar/wind system provides 24-hour power for our refrigerator and some lights and fans (the essentials).
